This week we have had a very successful 'Odd Sock Day' in order to raise awareness of Down Syndrome. This event has been a great success with the students and staff making a great effort to get the message out for this worthwhile cause. Following on from there..... Tuesday, 2nd April is Autism Awareness Day for us at Endeavour Schools. We will be having a range of activities during recess and lunchtime to encourage all Endeavour students to learn about and support other students and people in our families and community with autism.

During recess students are invited to participate in an obstacle course in the Undercover Area and see how many laps of the obstacle course they can do. Then at lunchtime, students will be able to purchase a 'jelly cup' from the Wave Area for just 50c (if they have their parents' permission of course).

We will be using Autism Association resources in our classes to raise awareness of how people with autism cope with their environment and other people. 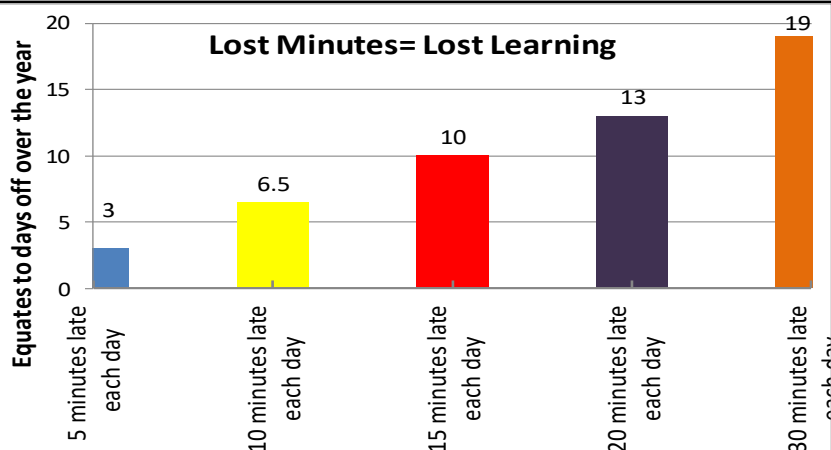

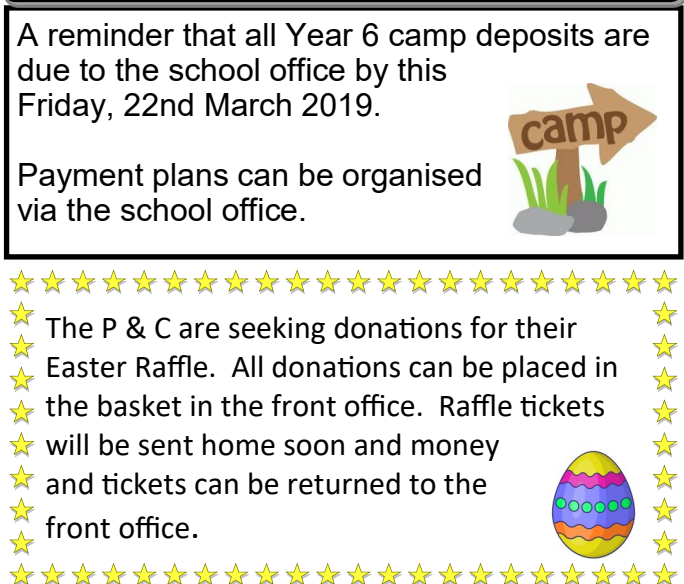

Year 6 Camp Deposits

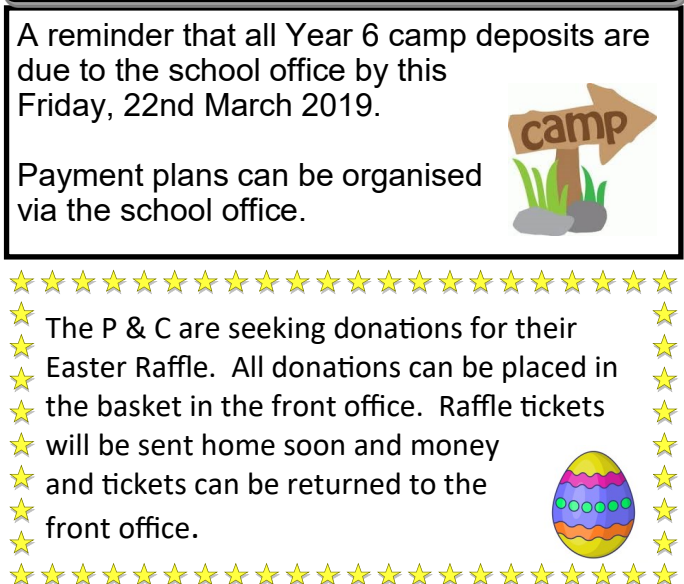
