Behaviour Policy

Over the course of this semester we have been reviewing our school behaviour policy. The reason for this review is based on two items: 1– School community surveys last year reported concerns with the management of behaviour, and 2– Our school self-assessment processes highlighted the need to adopt different approaches to support managing behaviour consistently across the school. We now have a revised policy that will be implementing from the start of next term. Our new policy has a strong focus on developing positive relationships with our students and a sense of connection to the school, and clearly defines what is expected by students and staff in relation to supporting student behaviour. From the start of next term I will communicate key parts of this new policy via the newsletter and a copy will be available on the school's website for you to view.

Winter Carnival

Unfortunately the Year 5/6 winter carnival was cancelled this week by the organisers due to the severe thunderstorm risk that was forecasted. A round robin fixture with Comet Bay PS will be held next Thursday (4th July 2019) in lieu of the winter carnival. I am particularly impressed with the effort our students put in to their own learning, trying their best and maintaining such high standards of work across all the learning areas.

In your child's report for this semester you will notice your child's Semester 1 attendance rate on the final page. Please take a moment when reading your child's report to reflect on your child's attendance. At Endeavour Schools our goal is for +90% attendance rate for ALL students. Does your child meet this target for Semester 1? Is there anything you can do to improve their attendance rate in Semester 2? Is your child's attendance rate affecting their learning?

Up until today the ESC overall attendance rate for all students is 92.3% which is cause for celebration, however we have 2 year levels where the total attendance rate for that year level is below 90% (89% and 87%) which we would like to see improve next semester. BUT.....we have 7 students from Kindy to Year 6 who have 100% attendance for Semester 1 who will be receiving a special certificate before the end of the term. Congratulations to these students and I hope to see even more students with 100% attendance next Semester.

School Lunch Boxes

Packing a healthy lunch for your child to bring to school each day will help give them the required energy and nutrition to do their best. Find below some handy healthy lunch box tips:



- ♦ A healthy lunch should include fruit, vegetables, wholegrains, meat or alternatives, dairy products and water.
- ♦ Keep lunch boxes interesting. Offer a variety of lunch foods including sandwiches, wraps, rolls and cold salads.
- ♦ Peer pressure and food marketing urging all children to try all sorts of foods can be very strong. Let your child try these foods occasionally.
- ♦ Keep food cold in the lunch box with a frozen ice block and insulated bag.



Year 3 & 4 Science @ Work

The Year 3 Science topic this term is Heating Up! We have been learning about how heat can be produced in different ways and how it can move from one object to another. The students have conducted investigations using ice-blocks, their bodies (i.e rubbing hands together), heat packs and spoons to compare the conductivity of different materials.

Our Year 4 students have been looking at Smooth Moves and investigating the effect of different sized forces. We looked at how forces are exerted on objects in games, such as through direct contact or from a distance. The students investigated friction, gravity (using balloons) and different sized forces on the motion of objects by making a catapult!
