Dear Parents, Caregivers and Community Members,

Welcome back to the second half of the school year. We have a number of new students and families commencing at Endeavour Schools this term and I look forward to you joining our Schools.

Behaviour Policy

Our revised student behaviour policy was officially endorsed by the school board this week and has now come into effect. From next week a copy will be available on the school's website. Over the coming weeks I will be mentioning specific items within the policy via the newsletter. Firstly, the Good Standing policy has commenced. All students are required to maintain their Good Standing in order to participate in a variety of extra-curricular activities. Good Standing is lost when students accumulate 20 penalty points via various behaviour incidents. If a student loses their Good Standing they are required to demonstrate the Schools' positive behaviour expectations for 10 days in order to have it reinstated. Secondly, students are not permitted to have mobile phones on them at school. If a student has a mobile phone (e.g. for use outside school hours) it is to be left at the front office and collected at the end of the day. Any incidents of students being found with mobile phones on them whilst at school will be addressed as a major behaviour issue as per the school behaviour policy.

School Board Open Meeting

The school board plays an important role in setting and monitoring the strategic direction of the Schools. Some of the issues they have been involved with this year include the revised behaviour policy, reviewing the 2018 parent surveys and approving the introduction of a long sleeve polo shirt. Each year an open meeting of the school board is held and I would like to invite parents and community members to this year's meeting. It will be held at the school on Tuesday, 13th August, commencing at 9:00am.

Nationally Consistent Collection of Data – Disability

As part of the annual student census process, the school will be involved in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data – Disability. This process seeks to collect data on school students with a disability who are receiving adjustments across Australia. The category of disability and type of adjustments being provided is collected. Students are only counted if there is evidence to support the adjustments being made (e.g. individual plans, parent discussions). Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Welcome back to Term 3, I hope you had a restful and relaxing holiday break and are ready for all that Term 3 brings.

I'm sure you will have noticed that works for our new buildings have begun! We have a 26 week building program and as with all improvement work there will be some disruption to access of the school grounds during the building period as well as some general noise disturbance. The building company are working with us to make sure that the disruptions are minimised with some of the extensive works being done on the weekends while students are not at school.

With the increased traffic around the school during the day, I'd like to please ask that you take care when parking around the entrance to the building site which is on the south side of Achiever Avenue close to the oval and school boundary.

When the buildings are completed we will have 1 purpose fitted ESC classroom, a dedicated therapy room and 2 offices which will be used by our school support services - Chaplain, School Psychologists, School Nurse, DSTA, etc. – allowing more places within our Schools for people to do their work with our students.

Our ESC Camp for 2019 will be held overnight at Alfred Hines Camp in Rockingham on November 7th and 8th and we are well on our way to finalising the details. Our wonderful P&C have kindly helped us out with paying for the bus costs for the camp, for which we are very grateful and thank everyone who supports the fundraising events run by our P&C to enable this donation. The ESC Staff Camp Fundraiser for this term is a Bunnings Sausage Sizzle next Saturday, 3rd August at Bunnings in Port Kennedy. Please save the date and come along if you can to say hi (and of course buy one of our sausage sizzles or a cold drink). Hope to see you then!

SCHOOL PHOTO DAY IS COMING!

Our school photo day is coming! Approximately two weeks prior to the photo day every student will receive a Kapture Photography order envelope to bring home. The recommended method of ordering your photos is online through Kapture's website as your payment is secure and can be easily verified at any time. If you pay online, there is no need to return the order envelope to school.

Alternatively you can pay by cash and return the provided envelope to the school **on the photography day**. Please note the photographers cannot open sealed envelopes and cannot provide change.

SIBLING ORDERS CAN ONLY BE PLACED ONLINE: Late requests cannot be granted.

You have the option to order a sibling photo package online, however please note **sibling orders will close in most instances at midday sharp at least one business day before the first photo date**. We suggest you place your online sibling order as soon as you receive your order envelope with your order instructions as places are limited.

Log on to kapture.com.au for your sibling photo order cut-off date and time.

Late payment envelopes cannot be accepted by the school office or by Kapture. You can place an order online for class or individual photographs at any time for the remainder of the current school year however a \$15 fee will apply if you order more than 10 days after photography.

If your child is in a sports or special group photo, you can use the same school code on your order envelope to view and order these photos on Kapture's website, around the time that school photos are ready to be delivered. Please note; Class group, individual and sibling portraits are not available to view online.

Kapture offer a money back guarantee for any parent who is not fully satisfied with their photo package. Should you have any queries before or after photo day, please direct them to the Kapture office on 9240 1714 or email enquiries@kapture.com.au.

All students will be photographed individually on photo day for school administration records AS WELL as included in their class group photo available for purchase to all families. Should there be any reason why your child should **NOT** be included in the photo shoot – please contact the school office.
