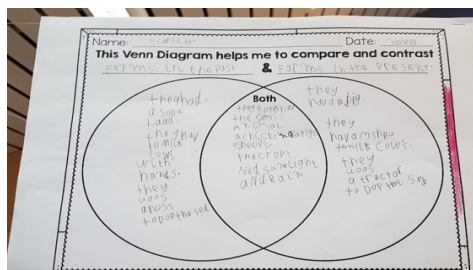

I shall be on Long Service Leave for the first three weeks of next term. During my absence Mr Greg Croll will be the Acting Principal.

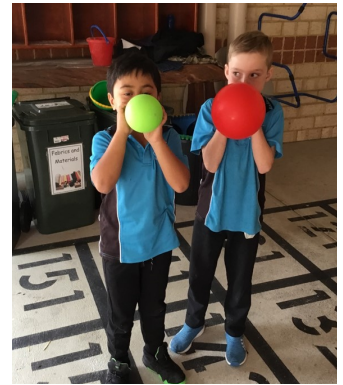
As this is the final newsletter for the term I would like to wish everyone a safe and restful school holiday break. School recommences for students on Tuesday, 15th October 2019

- ♦ Freeze bananas, grapes, strawberries and oranges for an icy snack.



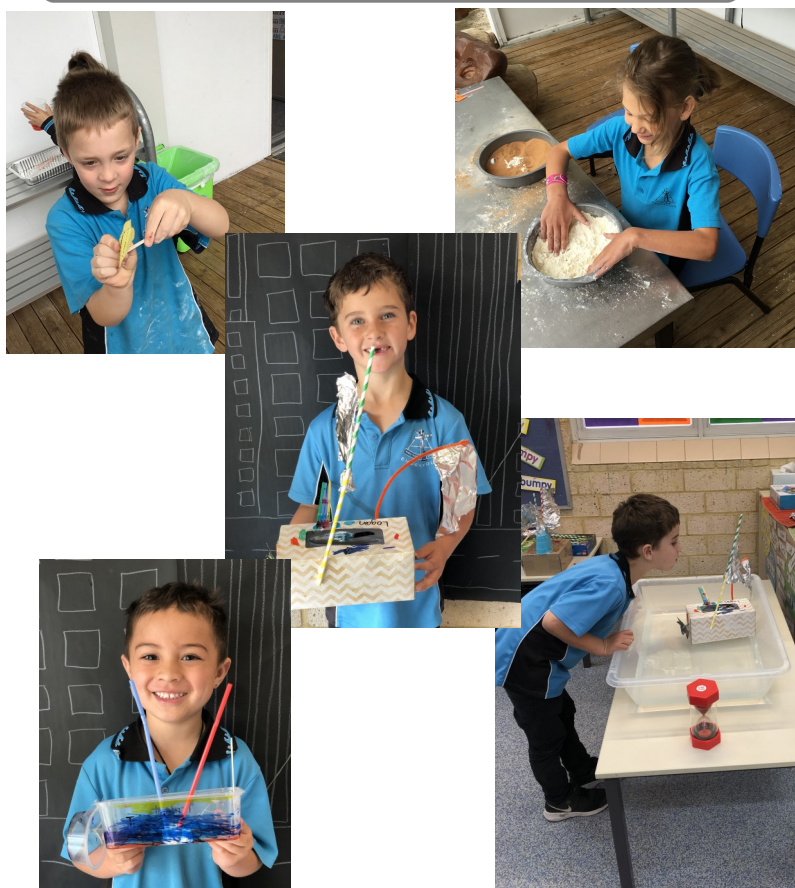
Author Visit – Dr Cameron Stelzer, The Story Doctor
