#### **Term 2 Arrangements**

Welcome back to the new Term – it is fantastic to see our students returning. It has been great to see their big smiles and hear about their holiday news. Our learning from home grids for this week were sent out at the end of the school holidays and will continue to be sent each Friday. If families have notified their teachers that they require a paper copy of the learning grids, these can be picked up from outside the school office on a Friday afternoon as follows (based on the first letter of your surname):

- A – H 1:00 - 1:30pm
- I – P 1:30 – 2:00pm
- Q – Z 2:00 - 2:30pm

When visiting the school office, please remember that only three people may be inside at any one time.

Our pick up and drop off processes are outlined below:

#### **Drop off in the morning**

- Families are encouraged to arrive as close as possible to 8:25am.
- Early childhood students are to be dropped off at the ECE service gates (double gates on Achiever Ave).
- Year 1-6 students may enter through one of the following three gates – Achiever Ave north (near the undercover area), front gate and south oval (near Rooms 23/24).

#### **Pick up in the afternoons**

- Early childhood students will be handed over to parents on the basketball courts. Parents are requested to stand on the painted dots and students will be handed over by school staff.
- Year 1 - 6 students may exit via one of the three gates as outlined in the drop off process.
- Parents are encouraged to organise with their child which gate they are to meet at when the day ends.

I would like to thank all our staff for their work, commitment and flexibility shown as we implement these new measures and learning approaches. They are a fantastic group who always have your child's needs at the forefront of their actions.

## Dental News

We are pleased to advise that the Australian Health Principal Protection Committee and the National Cabinet have recommended an ease to certain restrictions on dental treatment. This means our Dental Therapy Centre will be able to carry out **most, but not all**, treatments for our patients.

We are currently reviewing all upcoming appointments and staff will be in contact by phone over the coming weeks to re-book those eligible patients previously cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. At this time please advise staff if:

- You have COVID-19
- During the past 14 days, you have come into contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19
- During the past 14 days, you have arrived from a place outside of Western Australia
- You are awaiting test results for COVID 19
- You have a temperature of 38 degrees or more or you have symptoms of acute respiratory infection – sore throat, cough or difficulty breathing.

Our clinic adheres to strict infection control guidelines, as the health and safety of patients and staff is paramount. As such we kindly ask that no more than one parent/guardian attend the appointment and that social distancing requirements within the clinic be adhered to (in certain instances, visitors may be required to wait outside). Patients attending the clinic without a scheduled appointment will be asked to return at an allocated time.
