

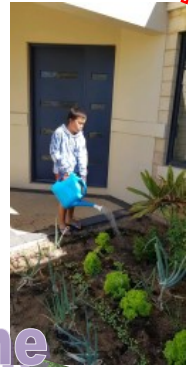


What 'learning from home' looked like for Rooms 20 & 23

Dear Endeavour Schools' families,
As you may be aware Mr Chris Burgess has moved on to a new challenge. I feel very excited about the opportunity to take up the Principal role at Endeavour Primary School. I look forward to meeting you all and encourage you to give me a call if you have any queries or concerns.

Thank you for your patience and flexibility as we navigate the ever changing, unpredictable world we are currently facing. A letter is being sent home today to outline the process commencing next week.

In order to cater for the larger number of students attending school we will be opening the gate near the Library as another drop off and pick up point. This gate will be open from tomorrow. Please organise with your child/ren which gate you are collecting from.

Please help us by maintaining social distancing at drop off and pick up. We will monitor this next week and make adjustments if necessary.

At this stage we will continue to follow our pick up and drop off processes:

Drop off in the morning

- Families are encouraged to arrive as close as possible to 8:25am.
- Early childhood students are to be dropped off at the ECE service gates (double gates on Achiever Ave).
- Year 1-6 students may enter through one of the following four gates – Achiever Ave north (near the undercover area), front gate, gate near library and south oval (near Rooms 23/24).

Pick up in the afternoons

- Early childhood students will be handed over to parents as per drop off.
- Year 1 - 6 students may exit via one of the three gates as outlined in the drop off process.
- Parents are encouraged to organise with their child which gate they are to meet at when the day ends.

I would like to acknowledge our staff and the work they have been doing to ensure our students continue their learning throughout the past few weeks.
