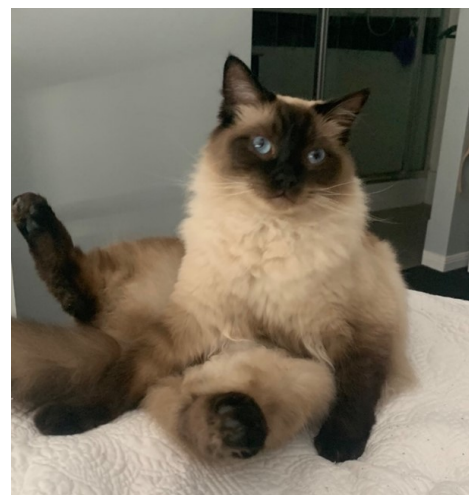
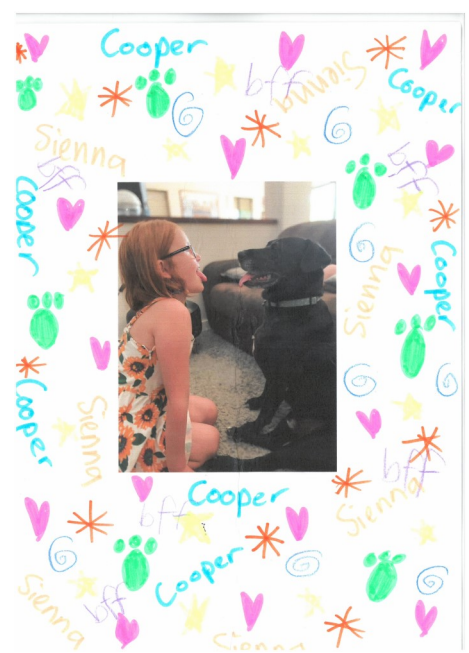
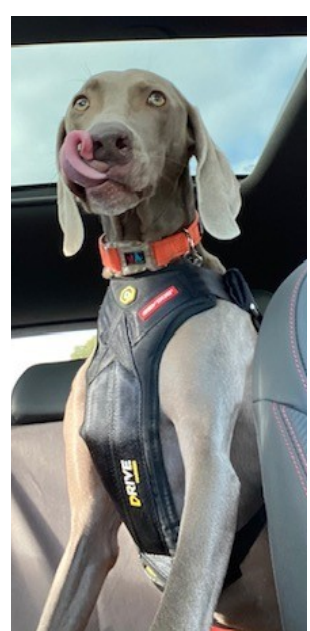


## Funny Pet Photo Challenge

As we move to the second half of 2020 we are working hard on gathering data to inform the development of our next Business Plan. 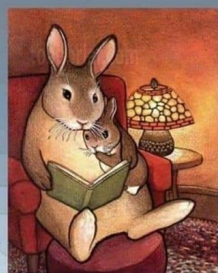
