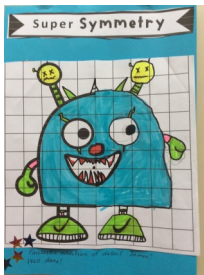




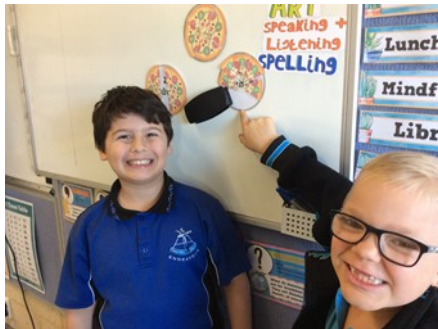

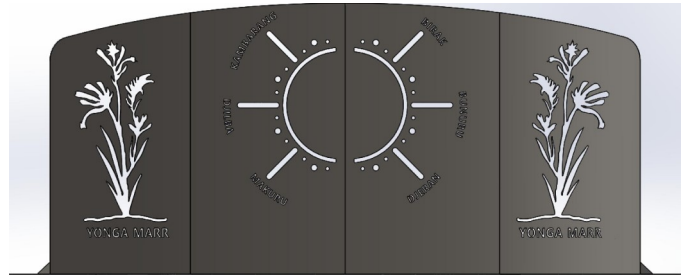
There is a lot of information coming home to you with this newsletter. Please don't hesitate to contact the school if you have any queries or concerns.

BIG NEWS.....coming up later this month we will have some building work happening for our new nature-based outdoor classroom. Nature-Based Play are going to be building us a stage and backdrop, tiered seating as well as a mini forest. We see this addition to our playground as being somewhere that classes can go, students can use at recess and lunchtimes and people can use to gather and chat at other times.



We have been very fortunate in being able to have Ash Collard design the stage backdrop artwork and I've been lucky enough to get a picture of the design to share with you this week.

We've been very busy in the office over the last few weeks getting our Schools Bushfire Plan updated prior to the start of the bushfire season. Coming home with this newsletter is a letter explaining what steps our Schools will take in the event of a planned school closure due to a bushfire. Our plan for any bushfire emergency situation is in place and available for everyone to read on our website www.endeavourschools.wa.edu.au

Later this term we will have an evacuation process practice drill with all our student and staff and will have one each term during the bushfire season.

Week 8 is eSmart week and we have a range of classroom and whole school learning experiences ready for our students. There is a cyber safety session for Year 4 – 6's which will be happening in the Undercover area on Wednesday. Each day there will be digital technologies out in the wave area at recess and at lunchtime with our staff supporting our students to use these and each classroom has access to activities and projects about being safe on-line.

With all this fabulous work going on in digital technologies, Mrs Maxfield and I have asked our classroom teachers to nominate a student from their class who has demonstrated excellent digital technologies skills this term to meet with us in Week 10 at the Principals' Afternoon Tea.
