

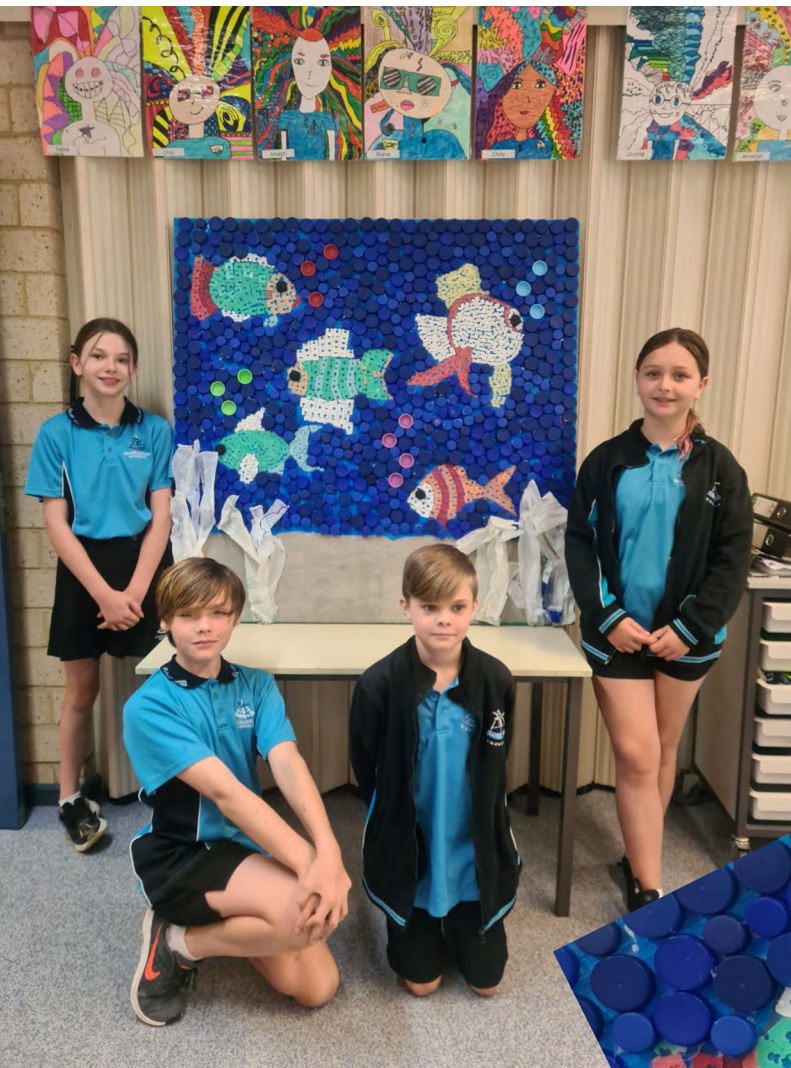

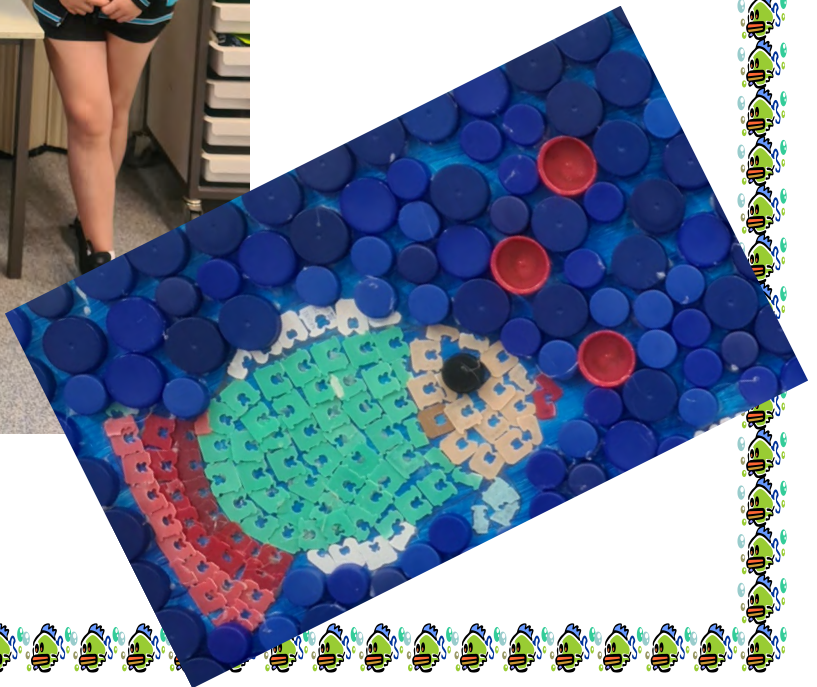
Save our Ocean
