
At this stage the cost for the Year 6 Camp will be approximately \$300.00. This will cover all food, accommodation and activity costs.

If you would like your child to participate in our Year 6 Camp, a deposit of \$50 is requested as soon as possible. This will need to be paid by the end of term, Friday 1 July and will ensure your child is factored into all groups, dorms and activities. Further payments will need to be made and payment in full should be completed by Friday 19 August. Regular payments can be paid at the office and receipts will be issued. More information will be made available soon regarding times, requirements and other arrangements. We will be holding a meeting at the start of next term to give further information and final camp costs.

Behaviour Expectations

You will show our expected behaviours everyday

Suspension - loss of good standing= strike.

Detention - you have to be removed from the classroom or playground = strike.

3 reflection sheets/C Zones to the end of the term = strike. Each step beyond adds to the "strike".

Each strike to be recorded in Principal's office, in the classroom and parents notified at the time.
